COST

The NEIRA league is a registered non-profit.

Entry to the regatta is **\$10 per person**. All gate proceeds are used to cover the costs of the regatta (rentals, police/fire/EMT, streaming, etc.)

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

GPS – Your GPS should be able to find the location by using “Regatta Point Park” in Worcester, MA. The Address is: 10 N Lake Ave, Worcester, MA 01604

From 290 East - Exit 21 and turn right onto Plantation St. Drive approximately 1 mile and turn left on South Rd (UMass Memorial Medical Complex). Utilize the parking garage on your right.

From 290 West - Exit 22 and bear right onto Main St. Proceed to second set of lights and turn left onto Plantation St. Drive approximately 1.25 miles and turn left on South Rd (UMass Memorial Medical Complex). Utilize the parking garage on your right.

From Rt. 9 Shrewsbury – Either turn right on N. Lake Ave and after approx.. ¼ mile take the 2nd exit at the round-about to go up the hill into the UMass Medical complex. Utilize the parking garage on the left. Or, turn right onto Plantation St. and after approx.. ¼ mile turn right onto South Road and utilize the parking garage on the right.

From Rt. 9 Worcester – Turn left onto Plantation St. and after approx. ¼ mile turn right onto South Road and utilize the parking garage on the right.

PARKING

Utilize the South Road Parking Garage in the UMass Memorial Medical complex. Parking along North Lake Ave is prohibited, only drop off may occur. Towing may occur along North Lake Ave.

A FREE shuttle is provided.

There is no parking allowed inside Regatta Point Park. Cars and trailers bringing food, etc. may only enter during scheduled drop-off hours and may only remain in the park for 10 minutes.

Gate Hours:

- Tent Set-Up: Friday 12pm to 7pm & Saturday (Race Day) – 6am to 7am & after the last race (approx. 5:45pm).
- Spectators: Race Day only – 7am to 7pm
