P RACE DAY PARKING

- **Food drop-off:** All food items must be unloaded before 7:00 a.m. on Saturday.
 - **Athlete drop-off:** Athlete drop-off will be allowed north of the main gate.
 - All team vans and spectators must utilize the UMass parking garage.
 - Utilize the South Road Parking Garage in the UMass Memorial Medical complex. Parking along North Lake Ave is prohibited; only drop-off is permitted. Towing may occur along North Lake Ave.
 - There is no parking inside Regatta Point Park (except for handicap parking). Cars and trailers bringing food may enter during scheduled drop-off hours and only remain in the park for 15 minutes. Your attention to and respect for this policy would be greatly appreciated.
